*For renovations and new construction: do not begin construction until plans have been approved by the Environmental Health Department of the Population Health Unit. Plans will be approved or rejected within 15 days after the date of submittal. No changes from the approved plans are permitted without prior written approval from Population Health Unit.

*Please note additional permits (e.g. electrical installation, land use clearance, grading, etc.) may also be required from other agencies. The plan check process may also include other provincial, regional and municipal departments such as building, zoning and fire department. *A final approval inspection of all construction and equipment is necessary to begin operation of a public pool. Upon approval a health license will be issued for operation.
